## EDITORIAL BOARD

Universal Health Coverage (UHC) means that all people have access to the full range of quality health services they need, when and where they need them, without financial hardship, according to the World Health Organization. It covers the full continuum of essential health services, from health promotion to prevention, treatment, rehabilitation, and palliative care across the life course. This initiative has been designed to meet Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and its underlying commitment, which is to "leave no one behind."

Delivering these services requires healthcare workers with an optimal skills mix at all levels of the health system, who are equitably distributed, adequately supported with access to quality-assured products, and enjoy decent work.

The UHC service coverage index increased from 45 to 68 between 2000 and 2021. However, recent progress in increasing coverage has slowed compared to pre-2015 gains, rising only 3 index points between 2015 and 2021 and showing no change since 2019.

In 2021, about 4.5 billion people were not fully covered by essential health services. About 2 billion people are facing financial hardship, including 1 billion experiencing catastrophic out-of-pocket health spending (SDG indicator 3.8.2), or 344 million people going deeper into extreme poverty due to health costs. The COVID-19 pandemic further disrupted essential services in 92% of countries at the height of the pandemic in 2021. In 2022, 84% of countries still reported disruptions.

In 2017, the United Nations General Assembly proclaimed 12 December as International UHC Day by resolution, making it an official UN-designated day to accelerate progress toward UHC as an essential priority for international development.

Ayushman Bharat, a flagship scheme of the Government of India, was launched as recommended by the National Health Policy 2017 to achieve the vision of UHC. Ayushman Bharat aims to move from a sectoral and segmented approach to health service delivery to a comprehensive, need-based healthcare service. It adopts a continuum of care approach, comprising two inter-related components:

1. Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs): These centres provide comprehensive healthcare, including maternal and child health services, communicable disease services, and non-communicable disease services.
2. Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY): This component provides health coverage of up to Rs. 5.00 lakh per family per year to poor and vulnerable families.

The Interim Budget 2024-25 allocated INR 90,171 Cr to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, a hike of 12.5 percent over INR 80,517.62 Cr (revised estimates) from the previous fiscal. This allocation will drive an increase in central sector expenditure to continue building sustainable healthcare infrastructure and system preparedness in the country. Under the budget for the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, INR 87,656.90 Cr has been allocated to the Department of Health and Family Welfare, while about INR 3,001.73 Cr has been allocated to the Department of Health Research. This allocation includes a capital budget allocation of INR 4,352.48 Cr. An additional INR 3,712.49 Cr has been allocated to the Ministry of AYUSH, up from INR 3,000 Cr in the previous fiscal.



## FAMILY ADOPTION PROGRAMME BY MBBS STUDENTS IN AIMS&RC

The Family Adoption Program is recommended as part of the curriculum of Community Medicine, beginning in the 1st professional year and progressing through the MBBS training program in accordance with GMER 2019 regulations. Orientation towards this initiative is integrated into the Foundation course, themed 'Field visit to community health centre'. This program aims to facilitate village outreach for MBBS students, with each student ideally adopting five families.



As part of this initiative, a total of 2,250 families across 11 villages have been adopted. These villages include Doddathattamangala, Mandibele, Dharmapura, Byrapura, Dandiganahalli, Harohalli, DasarahalliBullilah, Muddanayakanahalli, Bidalur, and Karahalli. - Dr. Shilpa discussed "Recent Advancements in Laboratory Medicine."


Following the talks, the speakers were acknowledged for their valuable contributions, and prizes were awarded to the winners of the poster-making competition held the previous day.




Case of Mucormycosis Rehabilitation




## GENERAL HEALTH CAMP
