GROWTH OF AKASH INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL SCIENCES IN THE PAST FIVE YEARS

Akash Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre has achieved an exponential growth in the past 5 years, receiving fame and acclaim. The institute has forged ahead and created a name in the field of health service and medical education. **At the onset of the Covid pandemic, following a request from the health minister Dr. K.Sudhakar, the institution was the first medical college in the state to set up an isolation ward for international travellers to identify latent Covid patients. Dr. M.K. Sudarshan, the chairman of the Covid-19 taskforce committee visited the hospital and provided his formulary for Covid-19 guidelines. During the next 15 days, 114 travellers and primary contacts of Covid patients were isolated.** A screening centre was also set up at the hospital to screen all travellers from alternate flights and buses to reduce the congestion of people at the Airport, during which 4500 travellers were screened.

The Covid pandemic brought out the best in the institution when we took the first initiative as a private hospital in providing beds to the government for patients suffering from Covid-19. During the course of the pandemic lasting two years, the hospital admitted and provided treatment for 12048 patients, the highest amongst all hospitals in the State.

Akash Hospital achieved greater heights when they were awarded “Excellence in Aesthetic Surgery & Cosmetology” in the Times Excellence Health Awards 2023-24, a proud achievement by the departments of Dermatology and Dental Sciences. Akash Hospital also received two more Times Health Awards in the recently conducted Times Health Awards - Excellence in Superspeciality Hospital and Excellence in Women and Child Health recently.

The hospital has also recently been certified under the Entry level Hospital Programme of NABH, a great first step towards complete NABH accreditation.

On the education front, Akash Group of Institutions has started the Nursing, Allied Health, Pharmacy and Engineering colleges in the past 5 years with more than 5000 students admitted till date.

The Institution also received approval and started postgraduate courses in the medical college four years back, and the first postgraduate of the institution has completed the course. The postgraduate courses are flourishing with great number of postgraduates in all the departments.

There are several other achievements of the Institute in the past 5 years which has elevated the status of the Institute and has helped carve a name in this field. This will continue to rise in the coming years with the efforts, support and continued guidance of the management and the hard work of all the institutional faculty.



One more milestone at Akash hospital! Heartly congratulations to Dr. Udaybhanu and team department of ENT and Dr Srikantamurthy and team department of Anaesthesiology for successfully doing cochlear implant surgery Great achievement first in Bangalore rural.

A Milestone Achievement in Cochlear Implant Surgery at Akash Hospital (AIMS & RC)

“The cochlear implant is not just a device; it is a path to the world of hearing that many thought was beyond reach. & quot;

A cochlear implant is a life-changing device that offers hope to those with profound hearing loss. It is a boon to a child born with deafness that helps to hear sound, and helping them to communicate and engage with the world around. This innovation in ENT has not only improved the quality of life for a child with deafness but has also provided opportunities for language development, education and social inclusion.

In children having not benefitting with hearing aids, cochlear implants bypass and directly stimulate the auditory nerve, enabling the brain to perceive sound. It consists of a microphone, Sound Processor and a Transmitter that capture sounds from the environment and converts them into digital signal. Internal Components include Receiver/Stimulator and Electrode Array surgically inserted into the cochlea, the spiral-shaped organ in the inner ear that stimulate the auditory nerve fibers. Each electrode corresponds to a different frequency of sound, allowing the user to perceive hearing over wide frequencies. Cochlear implants are very expensive and beyond reach to many prelingual children born with deafness.

Surgically an incision in the natural fold behind the ear is made to minimize scarring. It involves mastoidectomy with posterior tympanotomy, a microsurgical approach to expose cochlear window and cochleostomy to create a small opening in the bone of the cochlea for insertion of the electrode array. This is done to preserve as much of the cochlea & 39;s sensitive membrane as possible while ensuring the electrodes make good contact with modiolus. The patient stays in the hospital for 3 days of observation. Initial Activation of cochlear implant is usually about 3 weeks post-surgery after wound healing. Auditory Rehabilitation Post implantation of a newborn child with deafness involves the mother, family of the child, speech therapist and operating surgeon to work in sync ensuring progress of the child.

This is the first of many such surgeries we hope to undertake in the future. With a purpose or motto that every child has a right to his / her hearing without any disability. There is no greater satisfaction than using our skills and knowledge to restore hearing in a neonatally deaf child, facilitating their rehabilitation and integration into mainstream life with good language development and hearing in collaboration with an auditory-verbal therapist.

ANTIMICROBIAL STEWARDSHIP WORKSHOP BY DEPT OF MICROBIOLOGY

Antimicrobial Stewardship workshop was conducted on November 21st, 2024 by the Department of Microbiology, AIMSRC as part of Antimicrobial Resistance week, Nov 18th to Nov 24th with the theme for 2024 being:

"Educate, Advocate Act now"

The workshop was informative and comprehensive with Dr Kavita N, Professor and Head of Department of Microbiology briefing us on the importance of Antimicrobial Stewardship. The first external speaker Dr A. S Valan, Public Health specialist from Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)-India presented the global as well as national perspective on Antimicrobial Stewardship and listed the various efforts to curb antimicrobial resistance at the national level.

This was followed by interactive role plays by the staff of microbiology and second year MBBS students on various Antibiotic susceptibility misinterpretations. The clinical dilemmas in choosing antibiotic therapy, escalation, de-escalation, intrinsic resistance, overlapping spectra of different antibiotic and treatment of multidrug resistant organisms were dealt with interesting case scenarios as group activities.

The importance of quality of sample and Infection Prevention and Control activities in containment of Antimicrobial resistance was emphasised in the workshop.

Dr. Sarika Jain Aggarwal from National tuberculosis Institute presented updates from National tuberculosis elimination programme especially on drug resistant tuberculosis.



Dr. K L Narayan, Professor, Department of Pharmacology, AIMS & RC gave a brief preview on pharmacovigilance practices as an important component of Antimicrobial stewardship.


CELEBRATION BY DEPT OF PAEDIATRICS


