
INAUGURATION OF AKASH INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

4. To facilitate access to healthcare in even the most remote parts of the rural community, we are adopting villages with the help of ASHA workers, which can help save many more lives.


Dr. Brijesh, MS, coordinated the activities, and the occasion was graced by VC Sree Amar Gowda.

THE INDUCTION PROGRAM OF MBBS STUDENT'S 7TH BATCH




Another milestone in the history of AIMSRC. Today was the induction program for the 7th batch of MBBS.




GANESHA VISARJAN


KARPEDICON CONFERENCE




INTERESTING CASE




